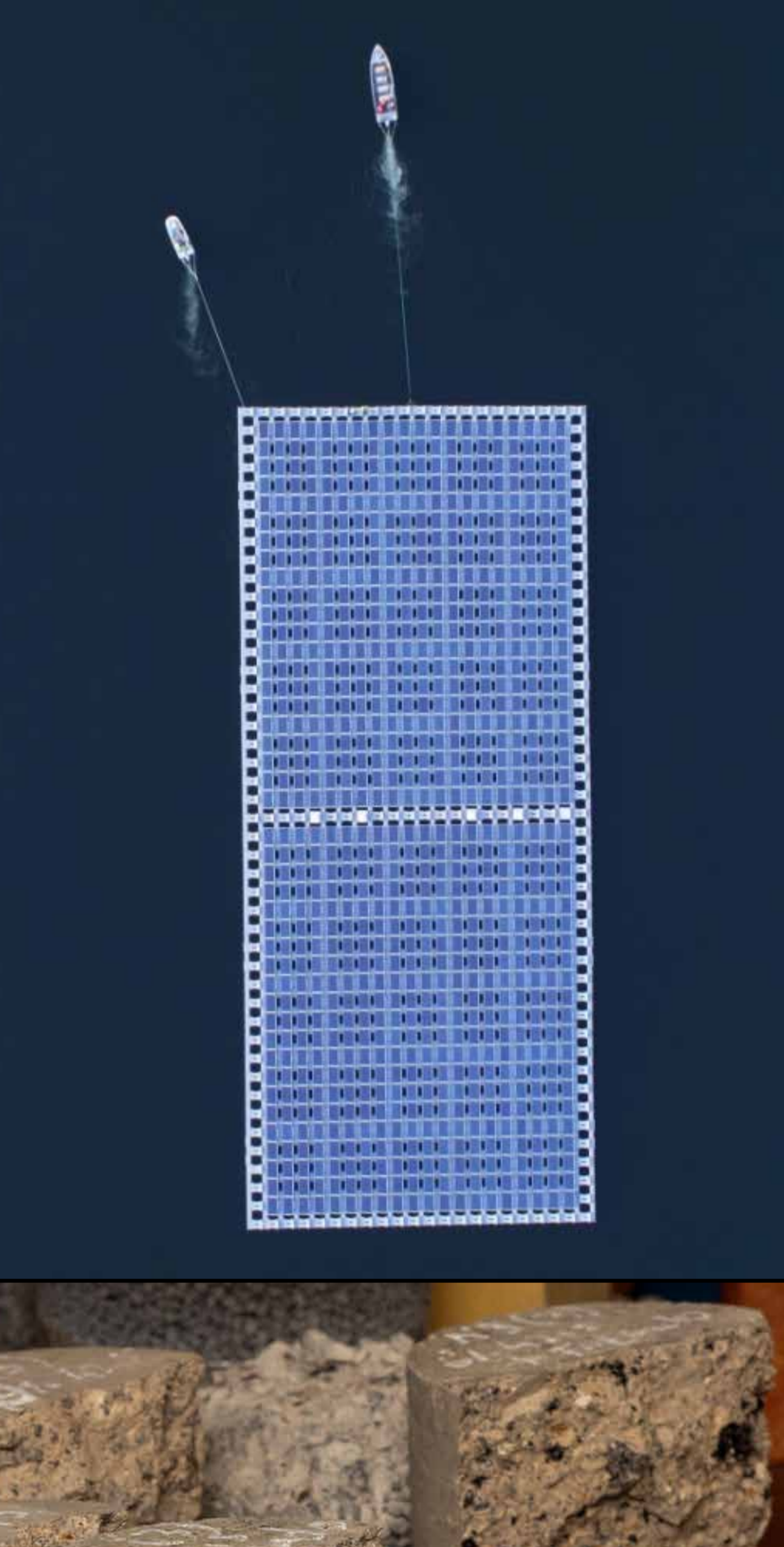
Nova Vila Retail Park

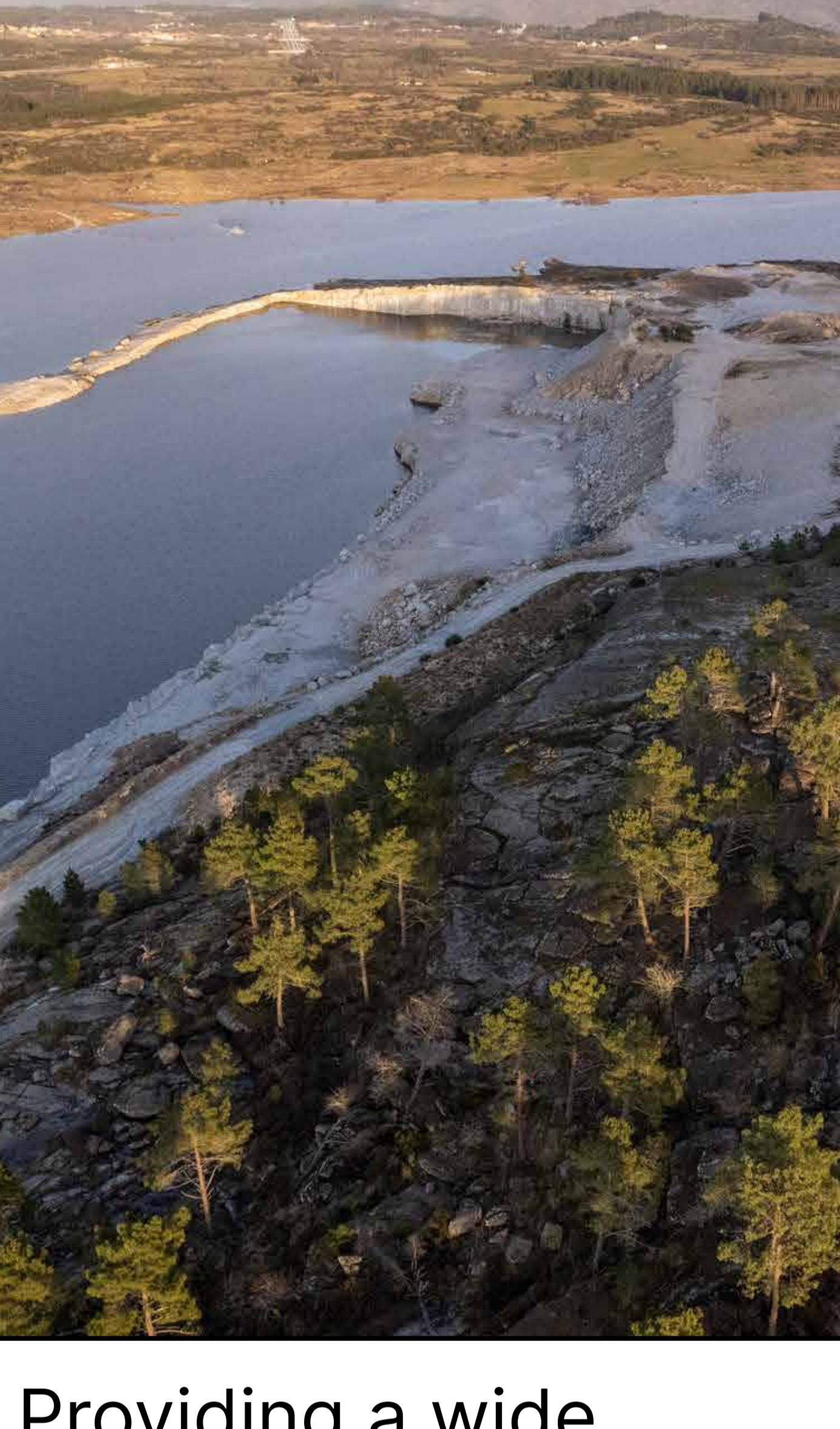
Another milestone in our history
